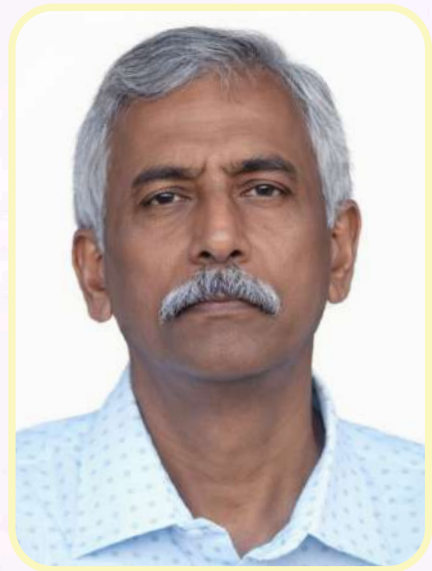

At a Glance- Rules and Regulations

Bodousa Senior Secondary School

Attendance

- Students must maintain at least 90% attendance. In cases of illness, a medical certificate must be submitted.
- Participation in school celebrations and events is mandatory.
- Penalties for Absence from school events will result in deduction of 5 marks per day from the total marks at the end of the academic year: Scholarship benefits may also be revoked.

Uniform and Examinations

- Students must wear clean, tidy and prescribed uniforms on designated days.
- Special attire may be allowed for school events with prior permission.
- Participation in every school exam is mandatory. Absence without proof during exams will lead to mark deductions in the final results

Events

- Guardians can meet designated persons between 9:00 AM and 1:00 PM.
- They must first report to the Social Welfare Officer at the Guardians Room.
- A "Guardians Entry Pass" is mandatory to meet hostelers; entry will be denied without it for security reasons.
- Guardians visit hostelers only twice a month (on the 1st and 3rd Sundays).
- Meeting Frequency: Guardians may talk to their children via mobile phone twice a month (2nd & 4th Sundays).

Guardians and Visits

- Unauthorized absence from school events will result in a deduction of 5 marks per day from the total marks at the end of the academic year: Scholarship benefits may also be revoked.
- For medical or special reasons, a formal application with evidence must be submitted to the principal.

School Timing and Leave Policies

- All students must arrive before the morning assembly.
- Generally, half-day leave is not permitted. The principal may consider it only for medical reasons or special circumstances with proper proof.

Prohibitions and Penalties

- Electronics: Mobile phones, cameras, and pen drives are strictly prohibited in the school and hostel. Items confiscated without prior permission will not be returned.
- Property Damage: Students must pay full compensation for any damage caused to school or hostel furniture and property.
- Intoxicants: The consumption or possession of gutkha, tobacco, or any toxic substances is strictly forbidden. Violators may face disciplinary action, including potential expulsion.
- Library Rules: Books can be used with permission. If a book is lost, damaged, or not returned on time, the student must donate 5 books to the library.
- Absconding: If a student runs away to home, a fine of ₹5,000 will be imposed. Repeated offenses will result in expulsion.

Fees & Responsibility

- Results, admit cards, and registration documents will be withheld if fees are outstanding.
- Always collect a signed and stamped receipt from the accountant to avoid future disputes.
- Attendance at guardian meetings is mandatory.
- Failure to attend meetings or respond to school calls may result in the students admission not being renewed for the next year.

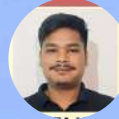

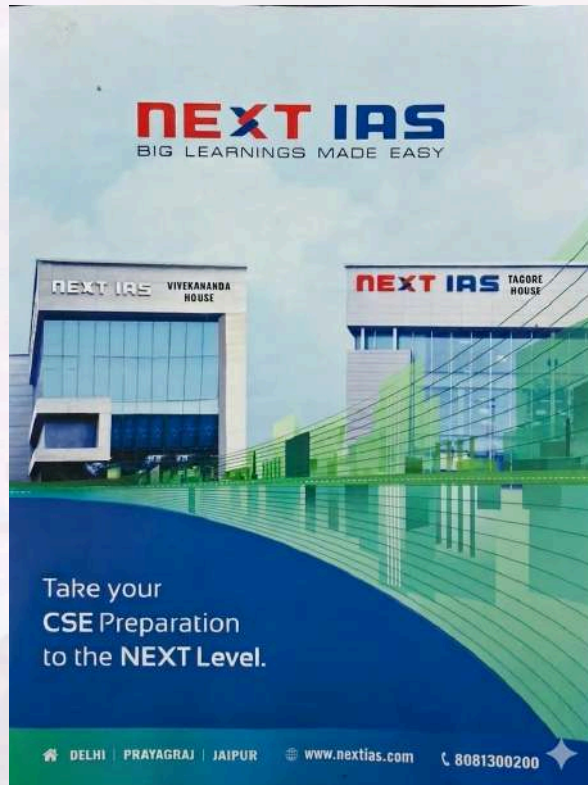
